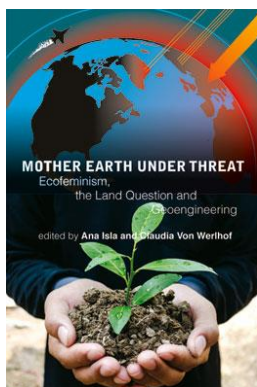

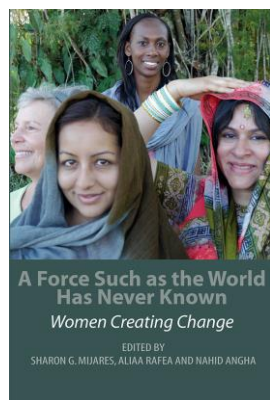
MOTHER EARTH UNDER THREAT Ecofeminism, the Land Question, and Bioengineering

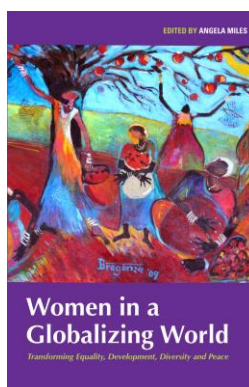

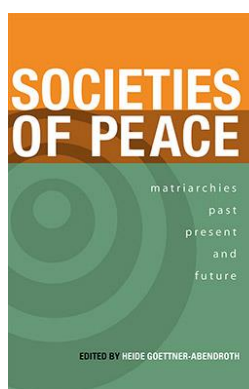
WOMEN IN A GLOBALIZING WORLD Transforming Equality, Development, Diversity and Peace

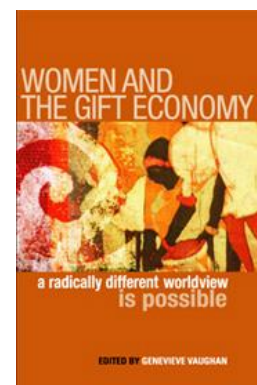
Matriarchies Past Present and Future
